Introduction

This day, focussing on short and informative sessions, is aimed at Health Care Professionals who have some previous experience of dealing with travellers in their clinics. They aim to delve deeper into areas which can often be considered more complex in Travel Health consultations and will also provide a forum to discuss any questions, concerns and tricky cases.

0930-1100 – Visiting Friends and Relatives Abroad (VFR)

According to NaTHNaC, those visiting friends and relative abroad travellers (VFRs) have a greater risk of travel related diseases and other health risks and are less likely to seek pre-travel advice. VFR travel abroad accounts for approximately 43% of all trips abroad from the UK.

This session will focus on why VFRs are at highest risk for many diseases, which diseases and how to increase compliance and manage risks.

1115-1245 – The Child Traveller

Children are at higher risk of developing severe malaria, rabies, complications for diarrhoea, respiratory infections, accidents and injuries plus more. This workshop will discuss their risks, how to manage them and some preventative strategies we can share with their parents/guardians.
